Please be aware that financial aid cannot be disbursed until the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is filed in February 2001. If your file is selected for verification by the federal processor, you may be required to submit 2000 tax returns to Centre College. Failure to submit the FAFSA will result in the loss of your entire financial aid award. Mail the FAFSA by February 15. Failure to submit the FAFSA in February may result in the loss of state grant funds (Kentucky residents only).

A second aid award will be mailed in the spring only if data submitted on the FAFSA is different than that submitted on this form. Submission of different information on the FAFSA compared to what is submitted on this form may result in a lower dollar figure on the second financial aid award.
