Students exempted from international fees

Certain International students may be eligible to pay the same fees as Québec residents. Students who qualify for an exemption from differential fees for International students pay the Québec resident fee plus medical insurance. The following are among those exempted.

- Diplomat, consular personnel, accredited representatives or civil servants of a foreign country working in Canada in an official capacity; and their spouse and unmarried children.
- An International student whose spouse or parent residing in Québec holds certain categories of work permits.
- An exchange student participating in a program of cooperation agreed to by the Government of Québec. Please see page 29.
- A student who is a French citizen (*accord cadre France-Québec*) and/or whose country has a fee remission agreement with the Québec Government.
