IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS (EFFECTIVE SPRING SEMESTER 2005)

According to the policies of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, applicants who have not previously attended Dalton State College must submit proof of all required immunizations certified by a health official.

The Board of Regents and the Division of Public Health of the Georgia Department of Human Resources developed the requirements and recommendations outlined in the tables below. The following immunizations are required of all new applicants to Dalton State College effective Spring Semester 2005.
