

**Q. What is an alumni interview?**

A. An alumni interview is arranged by our office upon your request. We have alumni volunteers across the country who conduct interviews for the admissions office. While we would prefer you to schedule an interview on campus so that you have an opportunity to visit St. Lawrence, we understand that it is not always possible. If you live within 100 miles of campus, we strongly urge you to visit campus for your interview.

**Q. When are alumni interviews offered?**

A. Alumni interviews are offered August through January. All interviews must be completed by the Regular Decision application deadline of February 15. Therefore, only requests received by January 15 will be honored. If you are applying under one of our Early Decision plans, the interview must be completed before the appropriate application deadline.

**Q. Are alumni interviews available in all areas?**

A. St. Lawrence alumni live across the country and around the globe. We can arrange alumni interviews in most areas of the United States. If we lack alumni coverage in your area, we will work with you on alternative arrangements. Our international coverage is very limited.
