# **HOW TO APPLY**

You should apply to Taylor University if something you have read, seen, heard or experienced about Taylor matches your personal goals for higher education. Taylor University desires a diverse student body to enhance the educational environment. We invite you to apply!

### INSTRUCTIONS

COMPLETE THIS APPLICATION IF YOU ARE NOT A U.S. Citizen or permanent resident. Applications that are received after December 1 must be accompanied by a nonrefundable application fee of U.S. \$20.00. Please attach a money order made payable to Taylor University.

- Read Taylor's Life Together Covenant thoughtfully (pgs 7-8). Your signature under "affirmation," pg 4, indicates your desire to comply with its requirements. It stands as a covenant between you and Taylor.
- Distribute the secondary school recommendation form by first completing the top (student) section and then giving it to the appropriate person for completion and mailing.
- 3. Distribute the pastor recommendation form by first completing the top (student) portion of the recommendation and then giving it to the appropriate person for completion and mailing.
- 4. Complete the enclosed affidavit of support form. International students must show evidence of sufficient financial support before the Form I-20 is issued. An official letter from the bank must accompany the form.
- 5. Distribute (if applicable) the scholarship statement form to the appropriate organization for completion and mailing.
- 6. Distribute (if applicable) the sponsor statement form to the appropriate person for completion and mailing.
- 7. Send us your official academic credentials. If credentials are in a language other than English, official translation must be provided. You may not provide a translation done by yourself. Any academic certificates must be certified as true copies or bear the school seal and signature of a school official. SAT and ACT scores must be sent from the testing center. Indicate code #1802 (SATI) or #1248 (ACT) when you register for the tests in order to have the test scores sent directly to us.
- Complete the application form and send it in the enclosed envelope to: Office of Admissions, Taylor University, 236 West Reade Avenue, Upland IN 46989-1001. (Always make a photocopy of your application.) We will evaluate your application when ALL materials have been received.
- Send us your official TOEFL scores. Scores must not be more than 2 years old. Indicate code #1802 when you register to

have the scores sent directly to us. **Photocopies** of test scores and scores that are **more than 2 years old will not be accepted.** 

The TOEFL may be waived for the following reasons:

- a. The student is a citizen of Great Britain, Australia, Canada, New Zealand or the British West Indies.
- b. The student has studied in one of the above mentioned countries or in the U.S. within the last 2 years and has a good academic record.
- 10. If you plan to become involved in Taylor's music program or in intercollegiate athletics, please complete the Music & Athletic Referral form (pgs 5-6). The Admissions Office will forward this information to the appropriate department(s) for consideration.

  - Completed and signed application form including essays
  - Completed recommendation forms
  - Affidavit of Support
  - Scholarship statement (if applicable)
  - Sponsor statement (if applicable)
  - Official academic records and test scores
  - TOEFL scores

# **Transfer Students**

Transfer students must submit the international application form, along with the Transfer Application Supplement, a pastor's recommendation, a secondary school recommendation and transcript and an official transcript from each institution previously attended. An official transcript must be sent from your secondary school. Generally, a B average is required. In addition, Taylor's Transfer Verification Form must accompany the transcript from the *last* college attended.
