- 3. Child Language Doctoral Program Application Form
- 4. Three copies of form for requesting Letters of Recommendation
- 5. Graduate School application form (please return this to the Graduate School directly)

Send these supporting documents to the Child Language Doctoral Program, in addition to the Application Form and fee:

- 1. A curriculum vita
- 2. A list of all courses taken in relevant areas such as child development, linguistics, psychology, special education, and speech and hearing sciences
- 3. A personal statement describing the applicant's interests in studying child language and professional goals
- 4. Two official transcripts
- 5. Three letters of recommendation
- 6. Scores from the Graduate Record Examinations*
- 7. Scores from the Test of English as a Foreign Language for those applicants whose first language is not English*

Fees:

Paper application -- \$55 domestic students and \$60 international students Online application -- \$45 domestic students and \$55 international students

*Both GRE and TOEFL examinations should have been taken within the last two years.
